The 'Carelink' service is a 24-hour community alarm and mobile warden service to enable elderly, disabled and vulnerable people to live independently in their own homes.

We are looking for enthusiastic, caring persons to join a committed team on a relief basis. You will be required to provide support services and respond to emergency alarm calls throughout the High Peak area. This service operates 24 hours per day, 7 days a week, 365 days per year. This is a relief post with no regular contracted hours. The successful candidate will provide holiday and sickness cover.

You must have experience in a caring role, and be able to cope with stressful situations. Applicants need to live locally have a clean driving licence and a contact telephone number. This is a challenging yet rewarding role, you must have excellent communication skills and you should also be able to deal with emergencies calmly and confidently. Due to the work involving vulnerable adults the post is subject to successful enhanced Criminal Record Bureau checks. It is illegal for barred individuals to apply for this job. First Aid and Manger lifting cushion training will be provided.
