- An individual or group may be nominated for more than one category, if appropriate.
- There is no age limit (except the 'young person of the year award') entrants must be under age 25)

## Judging

- A panel of representatives from Tenants, Residents and Staff will decide winning nominees.

# Tenant community awards nomination form

Community volunteers are often unsung heroes really making a difference to your community.

If you know someone like this, why not show them how much you appreciate what he or she is doing by nominating them for a **TENANT COMMUNITY AWARD.**

Do you know that special adult or young person who benefits a neighbourhood managed by High Peak Community Housing? It could be someone who spends time, without pay, doing something to benefit their community. They may be an active member of a community group, organise events for tenants & residents in neighbourhoods managed by High Peak Community Housing or maybe they support or help an individual in the area.

If you do and really appreciate what they are doing, why not nominate them for a Tenant Community Award.

## The categories are:

### Young Person of the Year Award

Awarded to any young person who is under 25 who lives in a neighbourhood managed by HPCH, and has:-

- Made a positive difference to their neighbourhood or;
- Made a positive contribution to promoting the views of young people or;
- Overcome personal barriers to achieve success; or
- Shown a commitment to intergenerational work.

### Good Neighbour Award

Awarded to resident who lives in a neighbourhood managed by HPCH, and has:-

- Gone “over and above” what a neighbour would normally do, or
- Always been on hand to help a neighbour, or
- Been a good neighbour just because.

The following two are given in memory of Walter Sutcliffe, a tenant and founder chair of HPCH Board.

### Making a difference in their Community Award – individual

Awarded to a resident who lives in a neighbourhood managed by HPCH, and has:-

- Encouraged the community to come together
- Encourages residents to have a sense of pride in their community
- Puts the diverse needs of their communities at the heart of all they do
- Promotes equality of opportunity to all
- Promoted an initiative that has made the community safer, healthier and/or greener
- Worked on an initiative that has improved the health and wellbeing of residents
- Worked on a project to benefit residents financially
- Worked on a project to benefit the knowledge of residents

### Making a difference in their Community Award – group

Awarded to a group in a neighbourhood managed by HPCH that has the same qualities as those in the individual category above.

### The Green Award

Awarded to a resident or group in a neighbourhood managed by HPCH, and has:-

- Made a difference to the local environment
- Cleaned up a green place
- Worked to transform an area of their neighbourhood
- Be actively involved in developing a community allotment/shared fruit and vegetable plot
- Encourages community recycling.

### Tenant Involvement Award

Awarded to a tenant of HPCH who has:

- Encouraged a greater involvement from others
- Is an advocate of both Tenants & HPCH
- Shown a great commitment to tenant involvement
- Goes that extra mile.
